Kilombero Rice:

As part of out Lent Study Group this year we have been looking at fairly traded food. Our study booklet from Christian Aid recommended Kilombero rice grown in Malawi. Only 1 in 3 children attend High School in Malawi, an impoverished landlocked country in South Eastern Africa. A Malawian farmer has to sell 90Kg of rice to afford the school fees for one child for a year. Fiona has obtained 20Kg of the rice which is now on sale in the church hall for £2.99 a Kg. If we manage to sell all 20Kg then we can order more and perhaps reach the goal of 90Kg.
